■ STATE OF THE WORLD

Out of 8 billion inhabitants, 3.42 billion live in regions that at least meet the simplest requirements of civil society, while 4.58 billion do not.

The best places strengthen families by protecting all family members from discrimination based on sexual orientation, while the worst regions violate the human rights of family members based on sexual orientation and therefore violate the right of all parents to have the human rights of their children protected.

(3) nineteen Brazilian states, plus Distrito Federal (DF) territory, rank Astounding.

(4) Western Sahara occupied by Morocco.

(5) Saudi government - the "royal" family - was installed by the USA government and remains in power only because of the USA.

(6) UAE government under de facto control of Iran.

(7) Kuwait government was installed by the USA government and remains in power only because of the USA.

(8) Military coup suspended constitution, etc. - previously ranked as MEDUSA - so coup overthrew a corrupt government.

(9) Military coup overthrew government, rule of law, constitution, etc.

(10) Much of USA failed states due to fundamental issues impacting all residents such as judicial corruption, constitutions that provide benefits to a minority of residents, mass human rights violations perpetrated by politicians and judges, insurrectionists and their enablers aiding and abetting them unconstitutionally holding office despite Constitution disqualifying them, failure to provide Equal Protection under Law to groups such as Women, Racial Minorities, Religious Minorities, Sexual Minorities, etc. The overall low ranking applies to U.S. Federal Government, and the failed states of Alabama, Arkansas, Idaho, Tennessee, Mississippi, Virginia, North Carolina, Utah, Kentucky, Louisiana, North Dakota, South Carolina, South Dakota, West Virginia, Missouri, Nebraska, Texas, Kansas, New Hampshire, Oklahoma, Wisconsin, Georgia, Ohio, Iowa, Florida, Indiana, Wyoming, Arizona, Alaska, Montana, which rank as MEDUSA. Pennsylvania ranks as Questionable. Sixteen states would rank Astounding if not subject to the federal government: Maine, Illinois, Connecticut, Oregon, Colorado, New Jersey, Delaware, California, Vermont, Rhode Island, Massachusetts, New Mexico, New York, Hawaii, Nevada, Minnesota, while Maryland and Michigan rank as Amazing and Puerto Rico ranks Excellent, Washington ranks as Good, and the U.S. territories Guam, North Mariana Islands, and U.S. Virgin Islands rank Good. American Samoa ranks Questionable.

(11) Judiciary committed act of genocide declaring rights only belong to people if they belong to a large-enough group. That declaration is the antithesis of Equal Protection under Law as well as Human Rights.

(12) Low ranking result of intellectually bankrupt UK Supreme Court gutting basic equality and nondiscrimination protections and principles for race, religion, sexual orientation, etc. in 2018, calling into question all laws in the UK. Other-wise regions would rank substantially higher.

(13) The Provinces of Saskatchewan and Alberta rank MEDUSA.

(14) Authoritarian leader and regime destroyed Democracy and rendered rule of law pointless. Leader wanted on international warrant for war crimes. Top court guilty of genocide.

(15) Low ranking result of government under de facto control of Nazi foreign U.S. Republican party sexually abusing LGBT children, and intellectually bankrupt UK Supreme Court in 2018 gutting basic equality and nondiscrimination protections and principles for race, religion, sexual orientation, etc., calling into question all laws in the UK.

(16) Failed state of corrupt sociopathic dictator harming millions of North Koreans. Best for military members to regain honor by removing dictator to restore freedom and human rights of their loved ones and neighbors.

(17) Failed state of corrupt monarchy with government guilty of crimes against all citizens.

(18) Failed state. Corrupt government officials, including members of top court, guilty of genocide, ending rule of law.
